The information provided below is intended for scheduling purposes only. Classes are offered 12 months each year. Here’s the next three (3) months:

INTRODUCTION SAILS (No prerequisite) 2 hour Introduction to Sailing trip, 10 AM – 12 PM Sat/Sun, 4 PM – 6 PM and 6:30 PM – 8:30 PM weekdays. Labeled IN. Introduction sails are scheduled on a space available basis. Introduction sails are conducted onboard a 30’ to 38’ wheel-steered, inboard diesel-powered, sloop-rigged keelboat with licensed Windworks skipper. They are designed to introduce new sailors to the sport and enjoyment of sailing Puget Sound. Call (206) 784-9386 for availability. Max 6 guests per boat.

BASIC KEELBOAT (No prerequisite) 24 hours of instruction consisting of three (3) eight hour classes, labeled BK1, BK2, and BK3. Classes are held in our classroom at Shilshole Bay Marina and "on the water" onboard a 25’ tiller-steered, outboard-powered, sloop-rigged keelboat. Classes must be taken in numerical order. This course qualifies the student to skipper a basic keelboat up to 25’ for day sailing. Weekend class are 9:00 – 5:00PM.

BASIC CRUISING (Prerequisite: Basic Keelboat) 24 hours of instruction consisting of three (3) eight-hour classes, labeled BC1, BC2, and BC3. Classes are held in our classroom at Shilshole Bay Marina and “on the water” onboard a 30’ to 38’ wheel-steered, inboard diesel-powered, sloop-rigged keelboat. These classes must be taken in numerical order. The course qualifies the student to skipper an inboard diesel, wheel steering equipped basic cruising vessel up to 38’ for day sailing. Weekend class are 9:00 – 5:00PM

NAVIGATION & PILOTING 12 hours of lecture instruction: four (4) three-hour classes in our classroom at Shilshole Bay Marina, labeled NP1, NP2, NP3, NP4. These classes must be taken in numerical order. Weekday eve classes are 6:00 – 9:00PM

COASTAL NAVIGATION (Prerequisite: Navigation & Piloting) 9 hours of lecture instruction: three (3) three-hour classes in our classroom at Shilshole Bay Marina, labeled CN1, CN2, CN3. These classes must be taken in numerical order.

BAREBOAT CRUISING (Prerequisite: Basic Keelboat, Basic Cruising, Navigation & Piloting and a MINIMUM of five (5) day sail outings as skipper on 25' to 38' keelboats / cruising sloops) 2 ½ days (30 total hours of instruction) "on the water" onboard a 34’ to 49’ inboard diesel-powered cruising sloop from Shilshole. Includes one evening planning meeting (vessel check-out, trip provisioning and weather briefing) and the following two full days. This is labeled as BBC on the schedule and qualifies the student to charter larger inboard diesel, wheel steering vessels for multi-day & overnight trips. Friday eve 6:00 – 8:00PM. Sat 9:00 AM through Sunday 5:00PM

BASIC POWERBOAT CRUISING (No prerequisite) 16 hours of instruction consisting of two (2) eight hour classes, labeled BPC1 and BPC2. Classes are held in our classroom at Shilshole Bay Marina and "on the water" onboard a 32’ wheel-steered, inboard diesel powerboat. Classes must be taken in numerical order. This course qualifies the student to skipper a basic powerboat up to 32’ for single day use. Weekend classes 9:00 – 5:00 PM.

GENERAL NOTES ON CLASS SCHEDULING: Reservations and payments are due in advance. Payment is collected at the time the reservation is made, securing your space in class. Please contact WINDWORKS at (206) 784-9386 to enroll. This schedule is subject to change for a variety of reasons. Please confirm your reservations in advance of attendance. Classes are held in most weather conditions, except heavy rains and/or strong wind conditions (relative to class level). **ADDED FEATURE!** Windworks Sailing Center provides foul weather gear free of charge for students while enrolled in lessons. Assume classes are "ON" unless you receive a call from WINDWORKS or have personally verified cancellation. If you must miss a class that you have previously scheduled, please call in advance to reschedule. If you must cancel your scheduled time within 3 days of class time (72 hours prior to class start time), the "LATE CANCELLATION" fee (\$75/lesson) will be assessed unless the class fills in your absence during the 3 day period. A "LATE CANCELLATION" on a class day that you have scheduled is \$75/lesson. This fee can be utilized for a make-up private lesson scheduled within one week, only redeemable mid-week (available only to students in Sat/Sun class series'). **CLASS TIMES:** Weekend sessions begin at 9:00 am and end approx. 5:00 PM (Sat & Sun).
